**#7 Kiss My Note** – Battled better; major class relief for tough connections.  
**#8 Buzzkillington** – Solid 2<sup>nd</sup> in turf debut last out; go to whoa threat with these.  
**#2 Distorted Ransom** – Big drop in for a tag for the first time; chance to awaken.

**Race 2**

**#6 Shot Glass** – First timer for capable barn in a race full of slow horses; bottoms up?  
**#5 Avoir La Vedette** – Steady improving; squarely the one to beat on paper.  
**#2 Glistening Star** – Blinkers off; Mr. John lured Robby...good as any in this one.  
**#7 Dreamily** – Showed little in first try; well-drawn outside with a right to improve.

**#8 Private Time** – Chased runaway winner in last; dropper stalks pace and pounces.  
**#5 Rippin Ranger** – Emphatic score on drop last out; earned today's class hike.

**#6 Sharm** – Deep closer is begging for a fast pace to kick at; gets up in time?

**#5 Jet Away Sue** – Narrow defeat in grassy dash debut; still has plenty of upside.

**#9 Prudence** – Big runs against tough lawnmowers; cuts back for this one.

**#4 Pastime** – Just missed despite trouble in most recent turf sprint; good as any here.

**#1 A Dixie Twister** – Proven grassy dasher gets back to what she does best; can do.

**#3 Billy Two Hats** – Serious class edge; drops in fresh...turfer proven on dirt too.

**#5 Tale of Honor** – Took extended vacation after claim; major threat fresh if right.

**#7 Political Justice** – Dull recent efforts with better; can awaken on the class drop.

**#4 Blueblend** – Even efforts of late; best of the rest...consider using in gimmicks.

**#1 Unmoored** – Chased monster in lone turf go; very well intended off the bench today.

**#4 Twinsanity** – Tackled toughies at CD; in the thick of this battle from go to whoa.

**#3 Red Hot Chile** – Adventurous trip in last; capable if his head is on straight today.
