Joe's SELECTIONS - 4/6-2/5 Race 3

#1 My Mystery - No secret who looks best here; should smoke these at a short price.

#2 Greely's Striker - Slow starts often cost her; looks like the best of the rest here.

#3 Sweet Betty - Flashes speed on best days; can hang around for a share today.

#8 Starship Aquarius - Forces the issue from the outside post; must dig deeper late.

#5 Justa Lady - Visually impressive in recent runs; keeps getting better and up to task.

#4 Melaleuca - Narrow loss to tough customer in last; go to whoa threat w/John.

#6 Clairenation - Fell short in comeback run; tighter for this and is very capable.

#2 Simple Surprise - Mr. Steve's other runner is proven at the trip; can't ignore.

#5 Grantastica - Tough loss in last; on top of her game and should handle this crew.

#6 Twinkles - Sharp maiden breaker; better than ever and well-drawn on the outside.

#3 Timido - Speedy filly drops in for tough team; should be prominent every step.

#2 Greely's Comet - Alert gate break is key; willing finisher picks up lots of pieces late.

#13 Harangue - Runs well on everything; fits well for a share if he can draw in here.

#10 American Sea - Hung wide but still closed in last on grass; on the improve.

#7 Seven Trumpets -- \$205K 2-year-old in training buy; dam a $\frac{1}{2}$ to \$350K Black Bear.

#2 Big Iron - Got discouraged battling Baffin in debut; major speed threat here.

#5 Fight On - ½ to versatile \$250K Two Weeks off; must respect Mr. Steve baby. #1 John Tippmann - Bred to sprint on both sides of pedigree; rail tough on first timers.

Joe's SELECTIONS - 7-2-5-1/6-4

Race 8

#7 Bonnie Arch - Taking big steps forward on the grass; looks tough to beat today.

#8 Kaylen's Revenge - Ran better than it looks in return; won debut race on grass.

#10 Oh Dear Lord - Tough loss in first run for Lovell; surely earned the class hike.

#4 Egg Roll - What you see is what you get; worthy of inclusion in gimmick equation.

#3 Family Label - Gets a fresh start in a soft spot; Calvin lured to the saddle... tough call.

#2 Social Icon - Finds a slow bunch; may be fast enough to run them off their feet.

#1a Babe Rahman Jan - Experienced on the grass; drops in for a tag fresh... two for one?

#5 Zemo - Debuts for Buff with turf influences in the pedigree; fresh face might.
