**Race 1**

**#4 No Partners** – Even efforts with much better; edge on the drop into easier spot.  
**#1 Woman of Love** – Off slowly in debut; drops in with 1<sup>st</sup> Lasix & blinkers.  
**#2 Swagger Lo** – Debuts for top team; turf pedigree...willing to fade if bet down here.  
**#3 Indysuglyduckling** – Broke slow & rushed up in debut; good as any here.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 4-1-2-3-6-5**

**Race 2**

**#3 Tizk Tizk** – Better since adding blinkers; turf route to dirt sprint...risk worth reward.  
**#7 Brave John** – Forward works for return; watch tote & check him out in post parade.  
**#2 Dark Arden** – Better than ever; tossed blinkers aside and scored local win.  
**#5 Bajan Cash** – What you see is what you get; include willing finisher in gimmicks.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 3-7-2/5-8-6/1-4**

**Race 3**

**#4 Zipperini** – Knocking on the door against talented lawnmowers; gets first run here.  
**#2 Zambian** – Better than ever; traffic trouble likely cost him a victory in last.  
**#6 Society Beau** – Talented, late running sophomore tests turf for the first time.  
**#1 Patrick's Day** – Blinkers back on; proven turfer might want more ground for best.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 4-2/6-1-5-7**

**Race 4**

**#10 Tale of Honor** – 2<sup>nd</sup> best to legit winner off the bench in last; looks like a standout.  
**#2 Lollipop** – Fired a fresh shot behind solid winner; tables to turn versus top choice.  
**#1 Seba's Dancer** – Beaten chalk last two; A-game would make him tough to beat.  
**#5 Golden Causeway** – 11-time winner training forwardly for seasonal debut.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 10/2-1-5/3-8-9-4**

### Race 5

**#2 Chigger Bite** – Bet down in disappointing debut; 1<sup>st</sup> Lasix, sharp works & bred for trip.

**#6 Major Munnings** – Full brother to talented Will Munnings; patience pays off?

**#1 Zorzor** – Adds 1<sup>st</sup> Lasix & blinkers off the bench; very well intended for sneaky team.

**#8 Russell Cave** – Full to all weather sprint monster Street Boss; watch for tote clues.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 2-6-1-8-/4-7-10-11**

### Race 6

**#9 Whyruawesome** – Got cooked in the pace in last; edge on the drop in tough call.

**#2 Man of Stature** – On top of his game & fits like a glove; can end long dry spell.

**#6 Mineyrownmalone** – Overmatched in last; sits catbird's seat behind hot pace.

**#3 Sharm** – Edged easier foes in last; willing finisher must be considered in gimmicks.

### Race 7

**#2 Two Sips** – ½ to G1 Ashland winner Sailor's Valentine; works say she's ready.

**#5 Miss Accuse** – Broke very slow & rushed up in debut; flies under the radar here.

**#1 Kelly's Humor** – Her dam earned \$100K on turf/all weather; Corey for Mr. Brad.

**#6 Binary Bourbon** – Her sire earned \$800K on grass; dam also has green blood flowing.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 2-5-1-6-8-7-4-10-9-3**

### Race 8

**#9 Super Shack** – ½ to \$190K Storm Belt; tearing up the work tab at Churchill.

**#4 Tiz My Lady** – Deceivably good turf runs last two; has performed well on dirt too.

**#6 Looks Super** – Rounding into top form; go to whoa (start to finish) threat here.

**#10 Trivial** – Trip compromised in debut; right to improve for tough team here.

**Joe's SELECTIONS – 9-4-6-10/8-2-3-7**

### Race 9

**#1 Yearning** – Deceivably good turf run two back; willing to excuse Polytrack clunker.

**#3 Por Favor** – Drops in with blinkers off; decent turf runs...fits like a glove w/these.

**#4 Racey Reecey** – Game 2<sup>nd</sup> in lone turf try two back; tactical advantage today?

**#5 My Sugar** – Came through as chalk with easier; connections likely over bet here.
